



Pro Finishes PLUS has developed a curriculum to provide auto body technicians with the training and certification required to comply with regulations mandated by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP), commonly referred to as the 6H Rule.

All technicians that use a spray gun must be trained on spray gun selection, spray techniques, spray gun maintenance, areas within the shop where spray painting may occur and environmental rules not later than January 9, 2011 to comply with this regulation.

Technicians at facilities opened after July 7, 2008 must be trained within one hundred eighty (180) days of startup.

Technicians at a new shop employment location must complete training not later than one hundred eighty (180) days after being hired.

The training must be documented and a refresher course is required every five (5) years.
